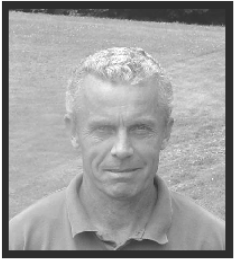




2010 TOD SILEGY RESIDENTIAL INDOOR SOCCER CAMP
